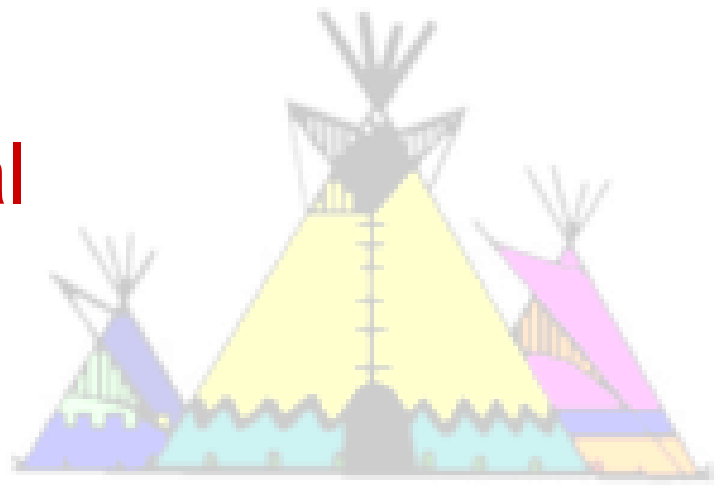


# Covid-19 Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) Program

WHAT TYPE OF RENTAL  
ASSISTANCE:

### *Who is eligible to receive assistance?*

- Low-Income Tribal members and other Indian Families Households with income that is at or below 80% of the Median Income
- Individuals with in the household that has qualified for unemployment benefits, or experience a reduction in income, or experienced other financial hardship
- Individuals within the household that can demonstrate a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing stability
